
Kazakhstan is currently the largest economy in Central Asia and is driving forward the modernization of its economy. In 2023, the nominal gross domestic product amounted to around USD 255 billion, with real economic growth of 5.1 per cent compared to the previous year. With a share of over 32 per cent, industry makes a significant contribution to overall economic output, with the mechanical engineering industry accounting for more than 13 per cent within the manufacturing sector.

In the mechanical engineering sector alone, Kazakhstan imported machinery and equipment worth around 20 billion US dollars in 2023. This sector is therefore one of the most important growth drivers in Kazakhstan's industry and benefits from a sustained high demand for modern technology and innovative manufacturing solutions. There are currently around 5,400 companies operating in the mechanical engineering and metalworking sector, which together employ around 115,00 people.

In addition, Kazakhstan is currently making great efforts to develop the engineering and manufacturing industry. To this end, the government has launched various programmes to promote this industry and has developed a comprehensive plan for the development of the engineering industry for the period 2024-2028. Thanks to continuous investment, the expansion of domestic production capacities and growing demand for high-quality machines and systems, the industry is continuing to develop dynamically and remains a central pillar of Kazakhstan's industrial value creation. This positive development offers German and international suppliers the best opportunities to operate successfully on the Kazakh market and to contribute to technological development together with local partners
